Events

All events will be similar to the events listed as part of the East Carolina Council's 2019 "Raiders of the Lost Scout" Camporee. Point values will events will be modified and are available on the score sheet. Below listed are the variances from the Camporee events.

- Willie Scott's Cooking Contest – **THIS IS A SCOUTMASTER EVENT.** Scoutmasters will prepare a Dutch Oven entrée at their Troop's campsite. The entrée will be presented for judging at 1:00 PM on the event field. The food may be presented in the Dutch oven, but the food must be transferred to a disposable bowl/plate for sampling by the judges. Scoring is based on participation--150 points. Bragging rights and trophy for the winning Scoutmaster. Results announced at Campfire.
- Mola Ram's Human Sacrifice Cooking Contest – **THIS IS A PATROL EVENT.** Each Patrol will prepare a Dutch Oven dessert at their Troop's campsite. The dessert will be presented for judging at 6:00 PM on the event field. The food may be presented in the Dutch oven, but the food must be transferred to a disposable bowl/plate for sampling by the judges. Scoring is based on participation--300 points. Bragging rights and trophy for the winning Patrol. Results announced at Campfire. Please don't kill the judges.

Event Rotations

The events will rotate as indicated below. Each Patrol's number will be assigned during the Leader's and SPL's meeting on Friday evening. The area chief will announce at the Saturday morning Flag Ceremony if the Primary Event Schedule will be used or if the Alternate Event Schedule will be used. The event schedule used will depend on how many adult leaders are available to manage events.
