ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE SWIMMERS AND PROVIDE RECORD

HOUSING: Participants should plan on **bringing their own tents**. Restrooms will be available.

REGISTRATION: All participants must register and pay by September 27th, 2019. There is no late registration, or at the door registration. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

No refunds will be issued unless the event is cancelled due to weather.
