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To register & pay online: visit WWW.ECCBSA.ORG under event flyers. Find Camp Charles Family Campout. Select "register" and this will take you to Tentaroo.

- If this is your first time registering for an event via Tentaroo, you will create a new account.
- Choose Camp Charles Cub Family Campout in the events & then create your roster for your family.
- *** **All members of your family will need to be registered** to receive the required arm band at check-in.
- PLEASE be mindful of the drop-down boxes so we can have an accurate headcount for this event. **If you are registering using the family maximum, please call Aimee Nethercutt @ the Scout Shop 252-522-1521** to make sure everyone in the family is registered & the price can be adjusted.
- After registering, click on the "cart" where you can enter your payment. & you will receive a receipt via email.
- The Camp Charles Family Campout is for all Cub Scouts and family members. See front for registration fees.
- On-line registration deadline is **October 19th, 2019**.
- On-site registration/check-in will begin on Friday at 5pm and Saturday from 8:00 am –9:30am. All families or pack leaders (if registered as a group) must check-in at the Hawley Cabin. Program areas open at 10:00 am.
- Check out is Sunday by 10am. You will need to provide your own meals for this event.
- All participants (including adults) are required to have a completed BSA Part A & B health form. These forms will be kept with each family or the pack leader & are subject to inspection at any time. Please visit <http://>
