

Scoutmaster Qualifications

All Jamboree Scoutmasters, First, Second, and Third Scoutmasters MUST meet the following requirements:

MUST have a current BSA membership with a Scouts BSA Troop.

Scoutmasters, First and Second Assistant Scoutmasters MUST be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.

Third Assistant Scoutmasters MUST be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.

Be approved by the ECC 2021 National Jamboree Committee.

Scoutmaster applicants MUST be currently serving as a Scoutmaster or have previously served as a Scoutmaster for a period of at least two years within the past five years.

First, Second or Third Assistant Scoutmasters MUST currently be serving in any adult troop or team leadership position.

Scoutmaster applicants MUST have completed Scoutmaster leader specific training.

All adult leaders MUST complete Youth Protection Training within one year of the last day of the Jamboree.

Meet the medical and BMI requirements of the Jamboree.

Participate and assist in planning the pre-Jamboree training experience.

Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 1, 2020.

Submit all registrations fees per the council's payment schedule.

DO NOT REGISTER AS A CONTINGENT LEADER ON THE NATIONAL JAMBOREE WEBSITE UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN TOLD THAT YOU HAVE BEEN APPROVED AS A CONTINGENT LEADER BY COUNCIL LEADERSHIP.

Venturing/Ship Advisor Qualifications

Venturing/Ship Advisors MUST meet the following requirements:

MUST have a current BSA membership with a Venturing crew or Ship.

Be actively serving as a Crew Advisor, Associate Advisor, Skipper or have previously served in one of those positions for at least two years in the previous five years.

Be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.

Be approved by the ECC 2021 National Jamboree Committee.

Completed their required leader specific training.

All adult leaders MUST complete Youth Protection Training within one year of the last day of the Jamboree.

Meet the medical and BMI requirements of the Jamboree.

Participate and assist in planning the pre-Jamboree training experience.

Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 1, 2020.

Submit all registrations fees per the council's payment schedule.
