This is the information packet for the 2020 Webeloree. Contained in this packet is the information and forms to prepare your Webelos for the Webeloree. This year’s Webeloree is the “Webelos of the Round Table”. All the events will be geared toward medieval times.

The cost per Webelos is \$10.

Leaders, parents, and Scouts is \$10.

The cost will be same regardless if you stay the whole weekend, one night, or just for the day.

TEAM Events:

There will be no ‘advance notice’ on exactly what the Team Events are going to be. None of the Team Events will require any advance training or knowledge. Since 2008, the Webeloree has been aimed at Webelos working as teams, not at Webelos activity pins / Adventures. If there is specific knowledge that the participants will need, they will be taught it at the station prior to the start of judging. Webeloree is a fun camping trip, not a “final exam”. **Exception:** there IS going to be the traditional ‘fire building’ event. Make sure all of your Webelos know Fire Safety!

All Scouts BSA units that would like to help by running an event. Please contact Mike Summers. This would be a great time for Scout Units to camp with their Webelos Den.

All Team Events will be 25 minutes (Webelos enter area, complete event, cleanup, and leave within 25 minutes) and 5 minutes for travel between stations. All Scout Teams move between stations simultaneously. All Morning Events start at 9am, conclude at Noon. All morning events are ‘divided patrol’ based. (All Webelos divided into equal size Patrols with no Pack affiliation)

All Team Events will be Scouts BSA / Venturer conducted.

Pack Events:

Afternoon events will be Pack-based, Staff conducted. (Volunteers Welcomed!) Pack Events will be conducted throughout the day.

Uniform Inspection:

(Saturday Morning)

Conducted per official BSA Uniform Inspection Form 510-750 Rev.4/18

(http://www.boyscouttrail.com/docs/uniform_webelos.pdf) All scores will be averaged for the entire pack, using the number of Scouts on the Final Roster.

Dutch Oven Event:

(Saturday afternoon)

Participating Webelos Leaders and/or (Asst) Cubmasters will make a complete recipe in a Dutch Oven from scratch (ie: Apple Crisp apples = pre-peeled apples in a bag...not the entire mix of apples, brown sugar, oatmeal, etc. in a bag)

The theme for the Dutch oven cook off is "**wild game**". The main ingredient must be meat from a wild animal (no domesticated animals) can include deer, wild caught fish, wild duck, etc...

If enough Scouts BSA youths wish to compete I will open up a Scout Dutch oven cook off. Only youth members will be allowed to compete. The above rules also apply.

Campsite Inspection:

(Saturday afternoon)

Campsite to be inspected for neatness / cleanliness and organization (no set pattern, just that there IS a pattern) See the attached Campsite inspection form.

Webelos Pack Events:

In the afternoon each pack will take part in the Quest for the Arrow of Light. Each pack will compete in a series of challenges and events.

Tabletop catapult: Each Webelo Den will build a tabletop catapult. It is not to be more than 2 feet tall and one foot wide. It must be able to launch a ping-

pong ball. Be graded on looks, distance, and accuracy. Must provide pictures of Webelos building it. The catapult must be operated and fired by a Webelo Scout. No tension springs will be allowed

Jester challenge: Can your den outwit the Jester

Tug of War: Battle it out against the Knight

Jousting: How steady can you hold your lance to capture the rings

Scored by anonymous judges on Crowd Appeal and Performance Skills. An Arrow of Light / Cross-over Ceremony will be available for those Webelos who are crossing over or about to be crossing over.

Neckwear. Triangular, plaid neckerchief secured by the Webelos rank slide.

Pants/Shorts. Webelos Scouts wear the official convertible Boy Scout pants or the official Boy Scout pants or shorts.

Notes _____

Belt. Official navy blue web belt cut to proper length with the Webelos insignia on the buckle. Cub Scout adventure loops are worn only on this belt.

Socks. Official green socks.

Shoes. Neat and clean.

Insignia.* Correct placement: left pocket, 5 points; right pocket, 5 points; left sleeve, 5 points; right sleeve, 5 points.
