

# Who is eligible:

All registered Cub Scouts who will be in 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade <u>during</u> the 2020-2021 school year.

\*Tiger Cubs – 1<sup>st</sup> graders <u>must</u> be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian each night and all Tiger adults must complete the BSA Youth Protection online training (<u>www.my.scouting.org</u>) and bring the completed certificate on orientation night. Do not mail it to the council office.

\*\*Other than the Tiger Adults, ONLY the Adult and older Scout Volunteers who have attended staff training will be allowed to remain on the campus with the Scouts during camp hours.\*\*

#### **Orientation**

There will be a Parent & Scout Orientation on Thursday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. in the Student Center at Craven Community College in New Bern. During this orientation, you and your scout will meet the leaders, receive the camp T-shirt, hear camp rules, and receive other information for parents and guardians.


## Please bring the following to orientation:

#### What to Wear

- \*Camp T-shirt daily (T-shirt provided at the Thursday night orientation)
- \*Shorts or appropriate lightweight pants
- \*Socks and sneakers
- \*\*<u>NO</u> Crocs or Flip Flops will be allowed at camp by Scouts or Adults\*\*
- \*Sunscreen and/or bug spray Must be applied at home. Camp staff members are not allowed to apply anything to a child.
