

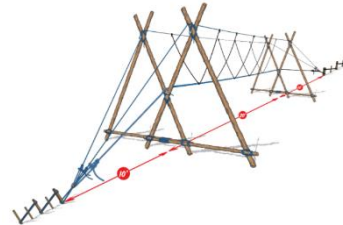


Wilson District 2020 Fall Camporee Just for FUN
