Registration is a 4 step process

- Notify your unit that you plan to attend this event. Please be prepared to tell them how many are in your group, that you paid online, and have completed the Google Form. Your unit will need your printed medical forms.

Each pack must have at least one BALOO trained leader camping with their pack. If your pack does not have a BALOO leader, we will pair you up with another unit.

Pre-registration is required.

Ages 4 and under are free.

Camping is free! Whether you come out just on Saturday or stay the weekend, the cost is the same.
