New volunteers must all take Understanding and Preventing Youth-on-Youth Abuse Training for Camp Staff, a live, one-hour course that Darcy will teach.

Orientation: River Park North, June 19. Parents/guardians come anytime 1 PM to 2 PM to drop off a completed medical form (https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-001_AB.pdf), receive camp shirts, and briefly review the camp rules as well as any other needed info. Please attend this important orientation, so the first day can run as smoothly as possible.

What to bring (remember to label everything):

- Cub Scout Six Essentials (filled water bottle, sunscreen, trail food, flashlight, whistle, first aid kit)
- Insect repellent
- Closed toed shoes that they can run in and get dirty
