This is a blended learning course consisting of a self-paced online session and an in-person session. The online session should take approximately 2 hours to complete and **must be completed before** the in-person session.

The purpose of the American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED Instructor course is to train instructor candidates to teach the basic-level American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED courses, select Skill Boosts and Bloodborne Pathogens Training. Graduates of this course will be added to East Carolina Council's Training Provider Agreement and are eligible to complete a Wilderness and Remote First Aid Instructor Bridge at no additional cost.

This course requires a minimum of, and is limited to, 6 participants. Registration closes on May 15th, 2022.

Eligibility:

Any Adult Leaders with a current basic-level First Aid/CPR/AED certification (or equivalent).

Cost:

\$170

This includes 2-year certification and course materials only – lunch is not included.
