Event Details:

The primary purpose of the American Red Cross Wilderness and Remote First Aid course is to provide individuals a foundation of first aid principles and skills to be able to respond to emergencies and give care in areas that do not have immediate emergency medical services response. This course satisfies BSA's Wilderness First Aid training requirement. This course is limited to 12 participants and registration closes on May 16th, 2022.



Eligibility:

All Adult Leaders with a current adult CPR/AED certification (or equivalent).

Adult CPR/AED is not offered as part of this course, but can be offered separately Friday evening if necessary for an additional cost – contact Chris Swift for more information.

Cost:

\$100 (Until 5/1) \$120 (5/1 – 5/15) This includes 2-year certification and course materials only – meals are not included.
