Twilight Camp is not possible without volunteers. Please register as a volunteer on Tentaroo and contact Darcy Guill if you can volunteer. We have a lot of positions that need to be filled including station managers, den leaders, and den walkers. All adult volunteers must have current *Youth Protection Training*. New adult volunteers must all take *Understanding and Preventing Youth-on-Youth Abuse Training for Camp Staff*, a live, one-hour course that Darcy will teach on Saturday, June 18th at 2 pm. We also need youth volunteers to help with dens and stations. They need to be 12 or older.

Orientation: River Park North, June 18 at 1 pm. Parents/guardians should come and drop off a completed medical form (https://www.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-001_AB.pdf), receive camp shirts, and briefly review the camp rules as well as any other needed info. Please attend this important orientation so the first day can run as smooth as possible.

What to bring: (Remember to label everything.)

- Camp t-shirt every day (provided at Camp Orientation)
- Cub Scout Six Essentials (filled water bottle, sunscreen, trail food, flashlight, whistle, first aid kit)
- Insect repellent
- Closed toed shoes (that they can run in and get dirty) - no flip flops, sandals, or Crocs

Daily Check-in/Check-out: Check in will be at 5:30 on Monday, June 20th. All other days, check-in will begin at 5:45. You must check your Cub Scout in and out each day except Friday.

Friday Picnic: We will celebrate the end of our *Wild, Wild West Twilight Camp* with a potluck-style Chuckwagon Chowdown, and the whole family is invited. Please check with your Scout's den leader for more information about what to bring.
