What is NYLT?

The National Youth Leadership Training Course is a two-weekend outdoor experience for youth leaders. National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action-packed program designed for councils to provide youth members with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home troops and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must BE, what he must KNOW, and what he must DO. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on HOW TO. The skills come alive during the week as the patrol goes on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership.

NYLT is a six-day course. Content is delivered in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment. Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of memory aids, which allows participants to understand and employ the leadership skills much faster.

Qualifications:

- Scouts BSA members (male and female) *must be at least 13* and fall within the maximum age allowance for their program registration. They must have completed **Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops** and attained First Class Rank.
- Ventures and Sea Scouts (male and female) *must be at least 14, or 13 and have completed eighth grade*, and fall within the maximum age allowance for their program. They must have completed **Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews or Ships**.
- A Scout may only attend on the Unit Leader's recommendation. It is important that the Scout have camping, cooking and hiking skills.
- *It is very important that all reservations are submitted through Tentaroo* (<https://ecc.tentaroo.com>) with full payment by **July 14, 2023**.
- There are only 48 seats available for this class. Anyone not fully paid by July 14, 2023 could be moved to the wait list.
